Careers


- Our students gain excellent skills and upon graduation are positioned to develop nuanced responses to the complex challenges facing the built environment in the 21st century.

Why study at The School of Art?


- Our students join a community of practicing artists, writers, critics and curators working across visual, material and sensual culture.

- An all-Steinway school. ECA is one of a handful of institutions with the prestigious all-Steinway status. All pianos owned by us are designed by Steinway & Sons.


