

What's different about Education in EFI?

- Interdisciplinary programmes taught by leading academics from different schools and disciplines
- Equipping students with the critical, data and creative skills needed to navigate a rapidly-changing world
- Students study online, on-campus or a combination of both
- We offer MSc, PG Diploma, PG Certificate or standalone courses
- Connecting with partners in the community, industry and government



Our teaching and learning model

- Community-focused: bringing students from across the world together as a single cohort
- Accessible intensive model: most courses are taught via two-day intensives with preand post-intensive activity
- Flexible fusion: offering students choice and flexibility around mode of study - online or on-campus
 - Online students can take 50% of their courses oncampus (providing there is capacity in the room).
 - On-campus students (who are NOT on a study VISA) can take 50% of their courses online.
 - If you have a study Visa you can NOT take courses online.



Our programme structure

Project (40 credits)

Integration (20 credits) Shared core (40 credits)

Programme core (20 or 30 credits)

Electives (60 credits)

Shared core' courses delivered in two hour sessions every two weeks.

All other courses delivered in 5- week intensive model
