Finance Portfolio

MSc Accounting and Financial Management

- A degree in accounting, finance, or related subject
- Degrees in quantitative disciplines or business studies will be considered if you can demonstrate strong background in accounting and finance

MSc Banking Innovation and Risk Analytics

- A degree in a management science, operational research, statistics, econometrics, mathematics, physics, computer science, or engineering
- Candidates with a degree in business, management, finance, or economics will be required to have covered some quantitative content

MSc Climate Change Finance and Investment

- A degree in business, economics, engineering, or a social or physical science

MSc Finance, Technology, and Policy

- A degree in finance, economics, engineering, or informatics incl. at least one course/work experience with significant statistical analysis and/ or programming

MSc Finance and Investment

- A degree in accounting, finance, business, or economics including at least one course/work experience with significant statistical analysis

Full-time or Online MBA

- A degree in any discipline
- A minimum of three year's managerial work experience
- For successful applicants, average is 7-10 years' work experience
- GMAT may be required

Admissions requirements

- Strong performance throughout undergraduate degree
- High grades in relevant subjects
- GMAT score is not required, although can be considered

Requirements and equivalencies

- UK: 2:1 Honours degree
- China: 85%; Band A
- India: 1st Class degree (60%)
- Indonesia: 3.2 GPA
- Germany: 2.2+ (reverse 5 point scale)
- Nigeria: 2:1
- Thailand: 3.0 GPA
- USA: 3.25 GPA (4 point scale)
